**PRAYER EXERCISE**

Make this a time of prayer and reflection. Remove distractions. Begin an authentic conversation with Jesus. Consider writing down thoughts or memories as they come to you.

*Thank you, Jesus, that You are here with me. I ask You to reveal truth to my heart and guide me in this time of prayer and reflection.*

- 1) There is so much more going on in our world today in the arena of politics. Jesus was very familiar with the dynamics of politics vs government. From our discussion today:**
  - a. What stood out to you about God's design for government?
  - b. What stood out to you about man's response to politics?
  - c. Ask God if there is anything He wants you to know about your beliefs toward government or politics.
  - d. Write down what he says.
  
- 2) As we get closer to this presidential election, conversations are heating up. As believers in Jesus, we have to check our heart motives.**
  - a. **Can you think of someone who is** very passionate about certain political issues or parties?
  - b. **Can you think of someone that is not passionate about the issues or parties you are?**
  - c. How do you respond to that person?
  - d. How do they respond to you?
  - e. Check in with your heart. What is your heart motive beneath your responses?
  - f. Ask God if there is anything He wants you to know about your own heart responses.

- g. Write down what He says.
  - h. Then ask Him what He wants you to do in response to what He showed you.
- 3) Jesus did not let politics distract Him from His mission and ministry, and neither should we.**
- a. In order to be part of the solution we have to have our hearts rightly aligned with God.
  - b. Will you seek God's heart for those people or issues that are on your heart?
  - c. Will you ask Him to give you His perspective on those people or issues?
  - d. Will you surrender your heart to God, and allow Him to use you as part of the solution for healing and building the Kingdom of God in your sphere of influence?

*Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.
